Daugherty and was his monthly salary as the Deputy Controller for the State, which was then a tidy sum of \$250.00.

Jeff Kintop, the NV State Archivist and his assistant Chris both inform us that in 1980's these cancelled warrants were sold as collectibles. They will both be properly framed and displayed.

They were both the gifts of Larry Fowler, the Parker County Sheriff. He stated that they were from an estate and when he saw where they had originated from, he looked us up and very graciously sent them to us free of charge!

The second gift is a set (quality and condition unknown) of Carson City silver dollars that were bequeathed to us from the estate of a California woman. We will keep you informed of that donation when they arrive in the next few months. Probate takes time.
