Dues for 2016 are \$25 for single membership (1 vote) and \$35 for a family membership (2 votes). Dues are due January 1, 2016.

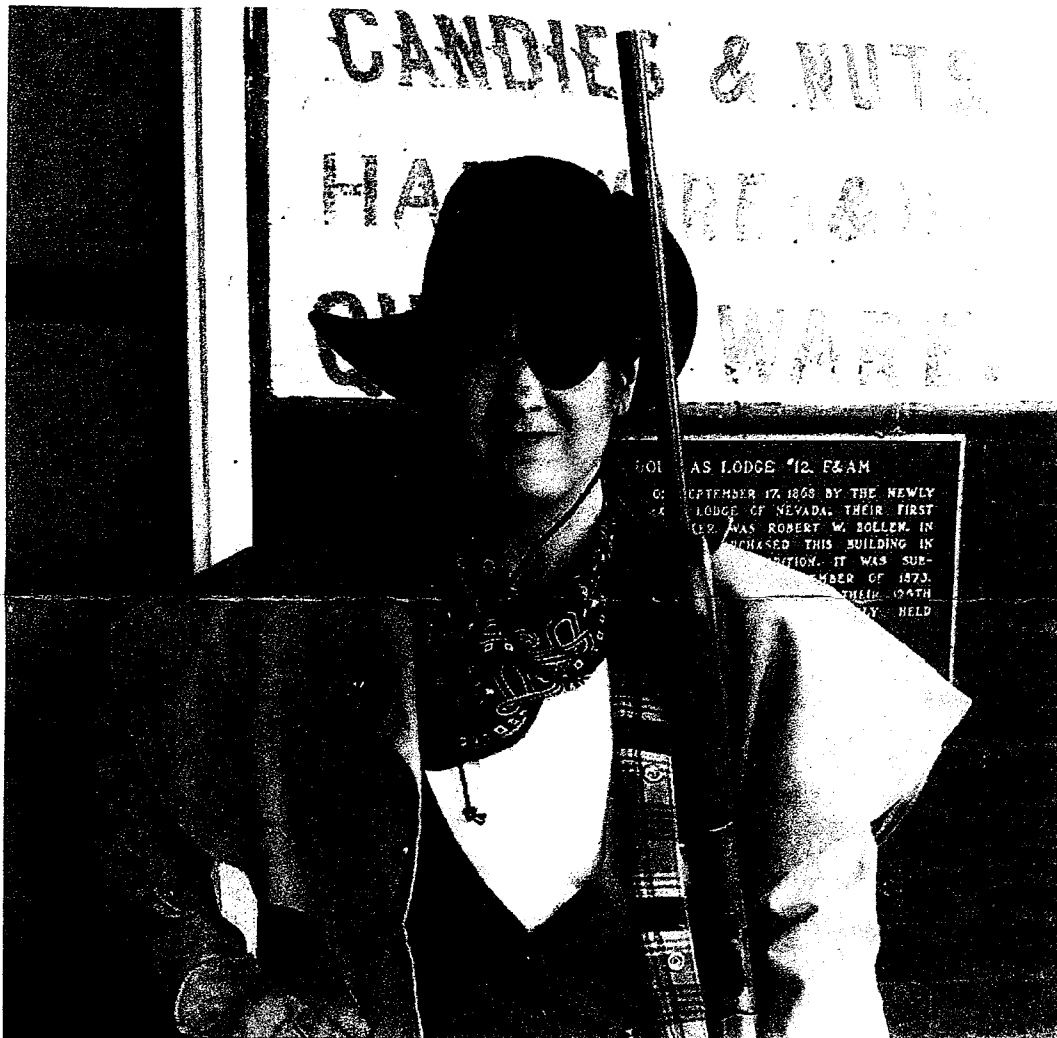
